



PICKS OF THE MONTH

A Complete Unknown (R)—Hollywood's golden boy Timothee Chalamet (Dune: Part *Two*) transforms into singer-songwriter Bob Dylan in this biopic. The film begins in 1961, when an unknown 19-year-old Bob Dylan makes his trek to New York from Minnesota and becomes part of the emerging folk music scene. On his way to becoming the artist we now know today, Dylan meets a handful of musicians like his idol Woody Guthrie (Scoot McNairy), Pete Seeger (Edward Norton), and Joan Baez (Monica Barbaro), who all play significant roles in his development as an artist. While the film barely made up its budget at the box office despite Chalamet's ingenious marketing tactics, it received eight Academy Award and three Golden Globe nominations. (Amazon Prime Video)



The epic period drama follows the heartbreaking story of Hungarian-Jewish Holocaust survivor Laszlo Toth (Brody), who immigrates to the United States after surviving the Buchenwald concentration camp and being separated from his wife and daughter. While he was a respected architect in Europe, Laszlo's first years in the U.S. are anything but respectable, until a wealthy client hires him for a luxurious construction project. Now with the promise of the American Dream and a chance to be reunited with his family, Laszlo assumes that his struggles have finally been rewarded ... but they've only just begun. (Apple TV+)

Matthew Perry: A Hollywood Tragedy (TV-MA) — Best known as Chandler Bing from the iconic TV series Friends, Matthew Perry shocked the world when he was found dead at only 54 inside of his Los Angeles home on Oct. 28, 2023. Since Perry was always open about his struggle with drug addiction, many suspected that an overdose was at play. It was later confirmed to be from a high dose of ketamine that was obtained illegally from two doctors. This documentary, out on Feb. 25, discusses the final days leading up to his tragic death, while also explaining his incredible rise to fame. (Peacock)

3. Smokey Robinson and the Miracles, in 1965. In 2021 it was ranked as "The Greatest Motown Song of All Time.'


4. Carly Simon, in 1971.



Winging It

Dear Annie,

We are having a big party and I want to serve chicken wings. Can you make some suggestions for recipes? Thank you. *Marilyn D from The Villages, Florida*

Dear Marilyn,

I love chicken wings. Here are three of my favorite recipes. If you are serving a big crowd, prepare all three recipes. —Annie

SWEET AS CAN BE WINGS

- 3 lbs. chicken wings
- ½ c. honey
- ¹/₄ c. soy sauce
- 4 T. brown sugar
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- ¹/₄ cup catsup
- Salt, to taste
- Pepper, to taste Paprika

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a shallow baking pan with aluminum foil. Place the chicken in the pan. Sprinkle with salt, pepper and paprika. In a medium mixing bowl, combine the honey, soy sauce, brown sugar and catsup. Pour over the chicken wings. Bake for 35 to 45 minutes. Test for doneness. Makes 18 servings.

BUFFALO CHICKEN

- 3 T. fat-free margarine
- 2 T. hot pepper sauce, or more to taste
- 1 tsp. canola oil
- 3 lbs. chicken wings
- ¹/₄ tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. freshly ground black pepper

3 celery stalks, cut into 24 (1-inch) pieces Blue Cheese dressing

Melt margarine in a medium nonstick saucepan. Whisk in pepper sauce and cook for 1 to 2 minutes, or until slightly thickened; set aside. Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Season chicken with salt and pepper, add to pan, and cook, turning occasionally, until browned on all sides, about 6 minutes. Add margarine mixture to pan and gently toss chicken until well coated, 1 to 2 minutes. Serve with celery pieces and blue cheese dressing. Serves 18.

FIVE SPICE CHICKEN WINGS

- 2 scallions, chopped
- ¹/₂ cup soy sauce
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup dry sherry
- ¹/₄ cup brown sugar
- 2 tsp. Chinese 5-spice seasoning
- 1 tsp. sesame oil
- 4 lbs. chicken wings

Using a large heavy saucepan, combine all of the above ingredients except the chicken. Bring to a boil for a medium heat. Add the chicken and simmer. Stir constantly. Cook for 30 minutes with a lid on the saucepan. You can find the seasoning in an Oriental grocery, if not available in your regular grocery store. Serves 12.





Know the Implied Odds By Jonathan Little

Whenever you face a bet at the poker table, it is important to consider your immediate risk, your future potential risk, and also the amount you can potentially profit. Sometimes you should play speculative hands — like small pairs and suited connectors — and other times they should be folded.

Suppose someone raises to two big blinds (bbs) and you have a solid speculative hand like the 8c6c on the button, which is likely the worst hand at the moment but can improve to a premium hand like a flush or a straight.

The amount you can potentially win from your opponent should be one of your main concerns. If you can only win a little bit from your opponent because they have a short stack of perhaps 26bbs or fewer, you should fold because the potential reward (26bbs) is not worth the risk (2bbs). This is expressed as 13:1 implied odds. You have to invest 1 unit to potentially win 13. If you are both deep stacked with 100bbs though, you should play because you will then be getting 50:1 implied odds.

As a generalization, in order to profitably play a suited connected hand like 7c7s or a marginal suited Ace like the Ah7h, you need

to be getting 20:1 implied odds or more, assuming you do not expect to be able to win the pot by bluffing too often. With small pairs, vou need about 10:1 implied odds. If you are not getting the correct implied odds either because the stacks are shallow or the initial raise is too large, you either have to fold or use your hand as a reraise bluff.

While small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors have implied odds, some hands have reverse implied odds, meaning they will usually either win a small pot or lose a large pot. The hands that have the worst reverse implied odds are a big card with a small card that are not suited, such as Ks6c or Qd7d.

Imagine you see the flop and make top pair, which is normally a strong hand. If you bet and all your opponents fold, you can be confident you had the best hand, but you are rewarded with only a small pot. If instead you bet and someone calls or raises, they could have a better top pair than yours or a worse hand, but you have no way of knowing which.

If you bet the flop and they call, if you continue betting on the turn and river, you will find that when you get called, it will usually be by a better hand, resulting in you losing a large pot.

Because of this, hands with large reverse implied odds should not be played in most situations, especially in multi-way pots or when the stacks are deep.

As stacks get deeper and the pots are played multi-way, you are more incentivized to speculate with hands that will either lose a little or win a lot, which are primarily the small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors. Folding the non-premium offsuit hands will keep you out of trouble and save you a lot of monev

A Wish Come True


