\* When you finish a wood-working project, save your leftover bits of sandpaper and use them to sharpen your scissors. All you need is a piece long enough to make a few cuts through.

\* "I just finished packing up my house to move, and this little tip was a dandy: Use a toothpick to keep the open end of your tape from disappearing. When you cut the tape, slip a toothpick at the end that's still on the roll. You will never have to go fishing for it again." — L.K. in New Mexico

\* If your water takes a minute to warm up, keep a pitcher by the sink. Let the water flow into the pitcher until it gets warm. Then, use that water (that otherwise would have been wasted) on your houseplants and in your garden.

**PICKS OF THE MONTH**

**A Complete Unknown (R)** — Hollywood's golden boy Timothee Chalamet (*Dune: Part Two*) transforms into singer-songwriter Bob Dylan in this biopic. The film begins in 1961, when an unknown 19-year-old Bob Dylan makes his trek to New York from Minnesota and becomes part of the emerging folk music scene. On his way to becoming the artist we now know today, Dylan meets a handful of musicians like his idol Woody Guthrie (Scott McNairy), Pete Seeger (Edward Norton), and Joan Baez (Monica Barbaro), who all play significant roles in his development as an artist. While the film barely made up its budget at the box office despite Chalamet's ingenious marketing tactics, it received eight Academy Award and three Golden Globe nominations. (Amazon Prime Video)

**The Brutalist (R)** — This A24 film led by Adrien Brody (*Asteroid City*) was also a critical darling, snagging 10 Academy Award nominations and giving Brody another shot

to land a Best Actor award. The epic period drama follows the heartbreaking story of Hungarian-Jewish Holocaust survivor Laszlo Toth (Brody), who immigrates to the United States after surviving the Buchenwald concentration camp and being separated from his wife and daughter. While he was a respected architect in Europe, Laszlo's first years in the U.S. are anything but respectable, until a wealthy client hires him for a luxurious construction project. Now with the promise of the American Dream and a chance to be reunited with his family, Laszlo assumes that his struggles have finally been rewarded ... but they've only just begun. (Apple TV+)

**Matthew Perry: A Hollywood Tragedy (TV-MA)** — Best known as Chandler Bing from the iconic TV series *Friends*, Matthew Perry shocked the world when he was found dead at only 54 inside of his Los Angeles home on Oct. 28, 2023. Since Perry was always open about his struggle with drug addiction, many suspected that an overdose was at play. It was later confirmed to be from a high dose of ketamine that was obtained illegally from two doctors. This documentary, out on Feb. 25, discusses the final days leading up to his tragic death, while also explaining his incredible rise to fame. (Peacock)

  4. Carly Simon, in 1971.
  5. "Hurt So Bad," by Little Anthony & The Imperials, in 1964. The song was a hit for the group, especially after they sang it on *The Ed Sullivan Show*. The song has been covered by numerous others, including The Lettermen and Linda Ronstadt.

### Winging It

Dear Annie, We are having a big party and I want to serve chicken wings. Can you make some suggestions for recipes? Thank you. Marilyn D from The Villages, Florida

Dear Marilyn, I love chicken wings. Here are three of my favorite recipes. If you are serving a big crowd, prepare all three recipes. —Annie

#### SWEET AS CAN BE WINGS

- 3 lbs. chicken wings
- ½ c. honey
- ¼ c. soy sauce
- 4 T. brown sugar
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- ¼ cup catsup
- Salt, to taste
- Pepper, to taste
- Paprika

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a shallow baking pan with aluminum foil. Place the chicken in the pan. Sprinkle with salt, pepper and paprika. In a medium mixing bowl, combine the honey, soy sauce, brown sugar and catsup. Pour over the chicken wings. Bake for 35 to 45 minutes. Test for doneness. Makes 18 servings.

#### BUFFALO CHICKEN

- 3 T. fat-free margarine
- 2 T. hot pepper sauce, or more to taste
- 1 tsp. canola oil
- 3 lbs. chicken wings
- ¼ tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. freshly ground black pepper
- 3 celery stalks, cut into 24 (1-inch) pieces
- Blue Cheese dressing

Melt margarine in a medium nonstick saucepan. Whisk in pepper sauce and cook for 1 to 2 minutes, or until slightly thickened; set aside. Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Season chicken with salt and pepper, add to pan, and cook, turning occasionally, until browned on all sides, about 6 minutes. Add margarine mixture to pan and gently toss chicken until well coated, 1 to 2 minutes. Serve with celery pieces and blue cheese dressing. Serves 18.

#### FIVE SPICE CHICKEN WINGS

- 2 scallions, chopped
- ½ cup soy sauce
- ½ cup dry sherry
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- 2 tsp. Chinese 5-spice seasoning
- 1 tsp. sesame oil
- 4 lbs. chicken wings

Using a large heavy saucepan, combine all of the above ingredients except the chicken. Bring to a boil for a medium heat. Add the chicken and simmer. Stir constantly. Cook for 30 minutes with a lid on the saucepan. You can find the seasoning in an Oriental grocery, if not available in your regular grocery store. Serves 12.

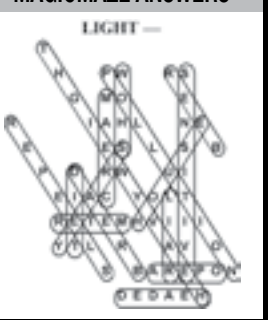

## Know the Implied Odds

Whenever you face a bet at the poker table, it is important to consider your immediate risk, your future potential risk, and also the amount you can potentially profit. Sometimes you should play speculative hands — like small pairs and suited connectors — and other times they should be folded.

Suppose someone raises to two big blinds (bbs) and you have a solid speculative hand like the 8c6c on the button, which is likely the worst hand at the moment but can improve to a premium hand like a flush or a straight.

The amount you can potentially win from your opponent should be one of your main concerns. If you can only win a little bit from your opponent because they have a short stack of perhaps 26bbs or fewer, you should fold because the potential reward (26bbs) is not worth the risk (2bbs). This is expressed as 13:1 implied odds. You have to invest 1 unit to potentially win 13. If you are both deep stacked with 100bbs though, you should play because you will then be getting 50:1 implied odds.

As a generalization, in order to profitably play a suited connected hand like 7c7s or a marginal suited Ace like the Ah7h, you need

to be getting 20:1 implied odds or more, assuming you do not expect to be able to win the pot by bluffing too often. With small pairs, you need about 10:1 implied odds. If you are not getting the correct implied odds either because the stacks are shallow or the initial raise is too large, you either have to fold or use your hand as a raise bluff.

While small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors have implied odds, some hands have reverse implied odds, meaning they will usually either win a small pot or lose a large pot. The hands that have the worst reverse implied odds are a big card with a small card that are not suited, such as Ks6c or Qd7d.

Imagine you see the flop and make top pair, which is normally a strong hand. If you bet and all your opponents fold, you can be confident you had the best hand, but you are rewarded with only a small pot. If instead you bet and someone calls or raises, they could have a better top pair than yours or a worse hand, but you have no way of knowing which.

If you bet the flop and they call, if you continue betting on the turn and river, you will find that when you get called, it will usually be by a better hand, resulting in you losing a large pot.

Because of this, hands with large reverse implied odds should not be played in most situations, especially in multi-way pots or when the stacks are deep.

As stacks get deeper and the pots are played multi-way, you are more incentivized to speculate with hands that will either lose a little or win a lot, which are primarily the small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors. Folding the non-premium offsuit hands will keep you out of trouble and save you a lot of money.

James White, of Harrison, was on his way to do laundry when he decided to stop at a gas station in town, lottery officials said. He had already bought two winning tickets, the first worth \$500 and the second worth \$50, and he doubted he could do much better than that. "I thought that would be the end of my luck," White said. White says he only buys tickets with winnings from other tickets or loose cash laying around. And with \$550 burning a hole in his pocket, he saw no reason not to try his luck one more time. White spent \$20 on a third ticket, playing the Frenzy game, officials said. He took it home with him, started scratching it off and by the time he got to the last row, he couldn't believe what he saw. "I stared at it for a couple of minutes," he said, then called up his best friend and told her the news: he'd just won the top prize of \$50,000. White told lottery officials he plans to invest the money into his house. Harrison is a roughly 140-mile drive northwest from Little Rock.

### Black Sheep Wins Big

A woman who recently won the lottery says she won't be giving any of the winnings to her family after they excluded her from a group trip. In a post shared to Reddit the anonymous 28-year-old woman writes that she comes from a family of five—her parents, two siblings and her. "Growing up, I was always the 'black sheep,'" she wrote. "My siblings were the golden children, and while I wasn't outright ignored, I definitely got the short end of the stick." Even as an adult, the woman writes, she's been ostracized—including recently, when her family "planned a big overseas trip" that she found out about via her sister's Instagram posts. When she confronted her mom, her mom said the budget was tight and she didn't think she'd want to come. Fast forward a month when the woman bought a lottery ticket on a whim and ended up winning over \$2 million. She used the money wisely, paying off debts, making investments, and setting some aside for fun. She didn't tell her family right away. But after she bought a new car her family began asking questions, and when she told them, they were "furious," she writes. "My mom said it's selfish to keep all that money to myself when they're struggling (news to me, given the vacation). My sister hinted that I should pay for her student loans, and my brother outright asked me to buy him a house," she writes. Now, the family is calling her an "ungrateful brat" and some Reddit users are commenting her family doesn't deserve any of the money.

### Late-Night at Lucky Pennies

### Frank Marino Signs Long-Term Deal

Las Vegas' longest-running headliner, Frank Marino, has signed a deal to appear "indefinitely" at Virgin Las Vegas. His show, Diva, Drag & Drinks, will run on select Fridays and Saturdays at 6 p.m., Sundays at 4, in the small 24 Oxford showroom. Tickets to see the 61-year-old Marino, who's been performing in Las Vegas for 40 years, start at \$49 (and come with a free drink).

### Horror in Time for Halloween

Universal's long-planned year-round "Universal Horror Unleashed" at Area15 will debut on August 14 in plenty of time for Halloween. The huge 110,000-square-foot attraction will feature four haunted houses, branded with Universal themes: Universal Monsters, The Texas Chainsaw Massacre, Scarecrow: The Reaping, and Blumhouse's The Exorcist: Believer. The four immersive venues will feature live entertainment, horror-themed food and beverage, and of course curated merchandise sales. Horror Unleashed will anchor Area15's 20-acre expansion.

### Backstreet Boys at Sphere

### Sundry Food Hall Goes Asian

The high-tech Sundry food hall at the Uncommons mixed-use development across the street from Durango closed in June after barely a year in operation. It's just been announced that the vacant space will be transformed into Stix Asia, with 12 Asian street-food outlets, along with a full schedule of holiday events, night markets, and live music. Stix is slated to open in early 2026.

## How to Play Against a Dealer's 9 Upcard

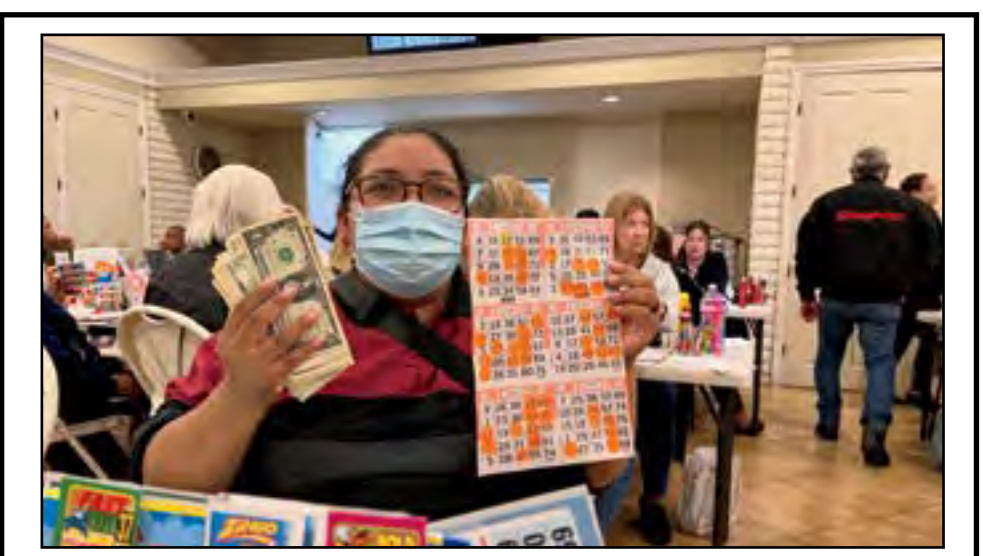
When a dealer shows a 9 upcard in blackjack, they have about a 77% chance of getting to a final hand that totals 17 through 21 and only a 23% chance of busting (depending on the number of decks shuffled). A 9, therefore, is a strong card for the dealer, which means we have to be more aggressive when we are dealt a stiff hand (hit rather than stand) and less aggressive when we are dealt a two-card soft hand (hit rather than double down).

We also should surrender one hand, even when it means we forfeit half our bet. What follows is the accurate playing strategy for any hand when the dealer shows a 9 upcard. Fortunately for players, the playing strategy against a dealer's 9 upcard is nearly the same for any number of decks of cards in blackjack or mix of playing rules, with only one exception discussed below.

**Notations used in this article:**  
S17 = Dealer must stand on soft 17  
H17 = Dealer must hit soft 17  
DAS = Doubling down after pair splitting is allowed  
NDAS = Doubling down after pair splitting is not allowed  
H = Hit  
S = Stand  
P = Split  
Dh = Double down if allowed; otherwise, hit  
Rh = Surrender if allowed, otherwise hit

**Playing a multi-deck game**  
Regardless of the playing rules, use the following strategy when facing a dealer's 9 upcard.  
Surrender if allowed, otherwise hit, if holding:  
• Hard 16  
Double down if allowed; otherwise hit, if holding:  
• Hard 10 and 11  
• Pair of 5s  
Split if holding:  
• Pair of As, 8s, and 9s  
Hit if holding:  
• Hard 5 through 9  
• Hard 12 through 15  
• A-2 through A-7  
• Pair of 2s, 3s, 4s, 6s, and 7s  
Stand if holding:  
• Hard 17 through 20  
• A-8 and A-9  
• Pair of 10s

What if you are playing a single- or double-deck game?  
The playing strategy for a single- or double-deck game is identical to the above multiple-deck game except for one strategy change:  
• Do not surrender hard 16; hit instead.

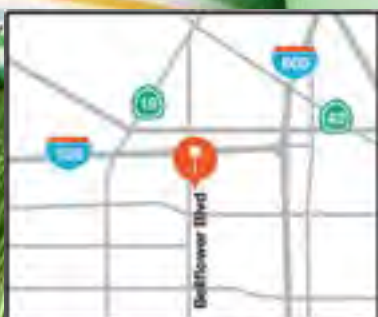
