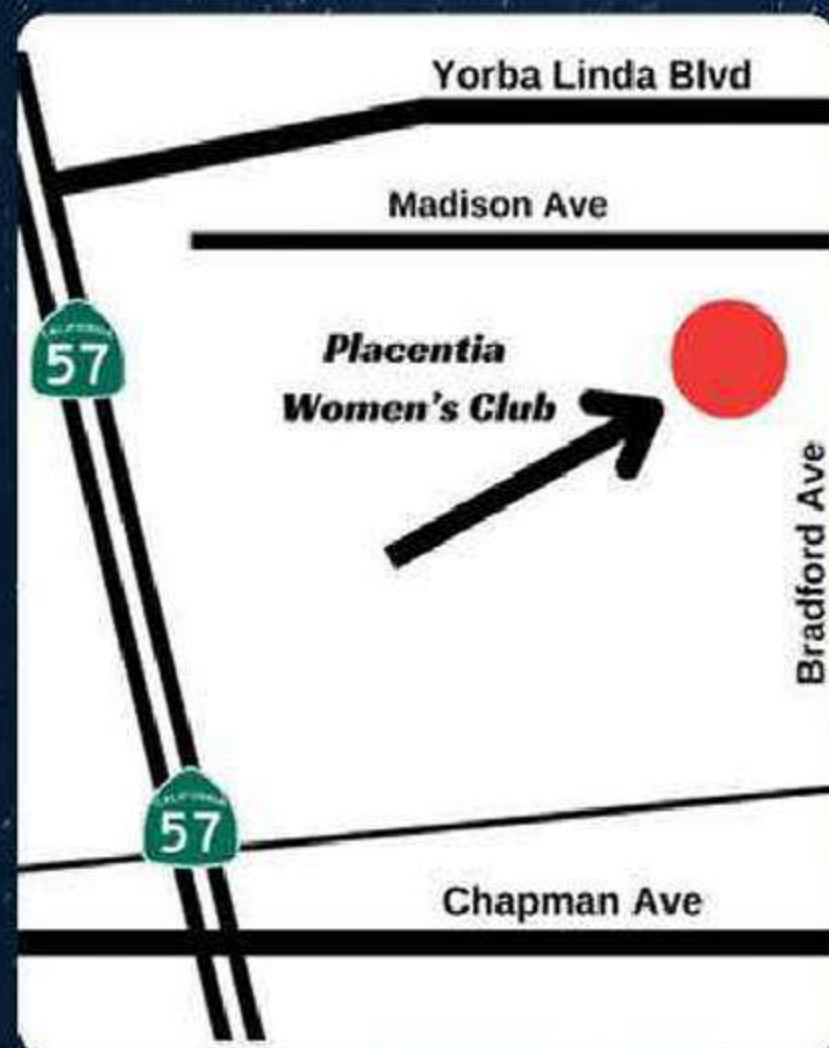

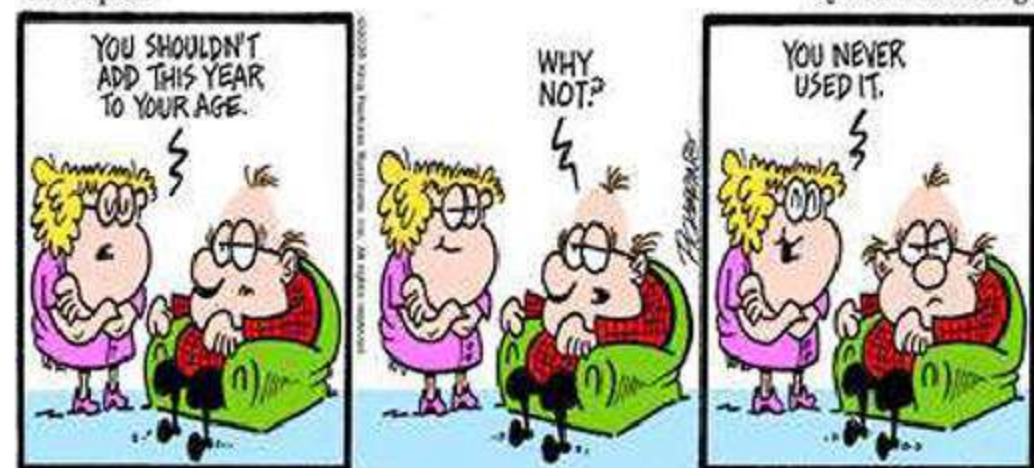

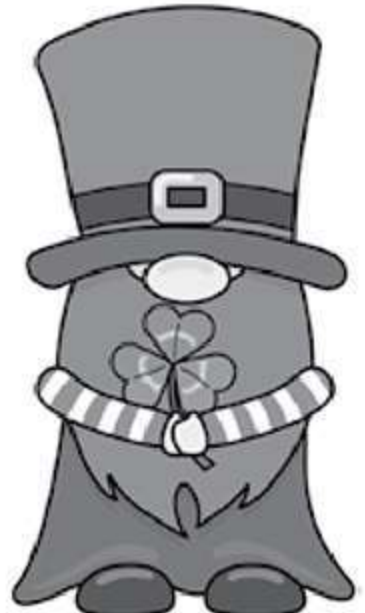
Million Dollar Bingo
A Winnipeg woman claimed Canada's largest Bingo Millions jackpot of \$1 million at Club Regent Casino last year, without even realizing she was the latest member of the millionaire's club. "The lady sitting beside me said, 'You just won a million.' I was like, no way and she's like, 'Yes you did.' Then I was surrounded by workers like I robbed the place, which I kinda did," Monica Bouma joked. "It still hasn't sunk in yet."

Bouma and her boyfriend were at Club Regent to play bingo and Bingo Millions and to get an early start celebrating her upcoming birthday. "He'd never played bingo, so he said, 'Since you like playing, you can teach me.' He was expecting a beginner's lesson, not an expert one," Bouman joked. "I looked at my screen and it showed two numbers away (from a bingo). The next two numbers were mine and I'm like, 'I got a bingo.'" Bouma is looking forward to taking life a bit easier and spending more time with her daughter. Monica won the \$1-million jackpot by covering her Bingo Millions card in the first 47 numbers or less. The game is only available in Canada at the Casinos of Winnipeg, which was the first Canadian property to offer it in December 2022.

Illegal Operator Boasts Online
The Kansspelautoriteit (KSA), the Dutch Gaming Regulator, sanctioned a Facebook user in the Netherlands for advertising and operating illegal games of bingo. While the identity of the individual hadn't been made public at press time, they were described as running a Facebook page called "Baco's zaalbingo" where they were selling tickets to bingo games and bingo booklets. Many of these games were held via livestream on the Facebook page. Not only did the Facebook account holder not have a license, but the prizes were "far above the maximum allowed by the law." Bingo games can only be offered by associations that have existed for at least three years, yet the operator admitted on Facebook that he's been doing it since 2022 and is not licensed. He is also not acting on behalf of any charities, as the proceeds benefit him directly. If he continues to offer bingo he may face penalties of €13,125 per bingo with a maximum of €131,250.

Online Bingo has become hugely popular, which I'm sure you discovered when you began your search. Multi-Deck Game
Regardless of the playing rules, use the following strategy when facing a dealer's seven upcard.
Double down if allowed, otherwise hit if holding:
• Hard 10 and 11
• Pair of 5s
Split if holding:
• Pair of As, 2s, 3s, and 7s and 8s
Hit if holding:
• Hard 5 through 9
• Hard 12 through 16
• A-2 through A-6
• Pair of 4s and 6s
Stand if holding:
• Hard 17 through 20
• A-7 through A-9
• Pair of 9s and 10s.
What about a double-deck game?
The playing strategy for a double-deck game is identical to the above multiple-deck game except for one change:
• If the rules specify DAS, split a pair of 6s (instead of hitting) against a dealer's 7 upcard. What if you are playing a single-deck game?
You should implement the same strategy change for a single-deck game as you would in a double-deck game, namely:
• If the rules specify DAS, split a pair of 6s (instead of hitting) against a dealer's 7 upcard.
For more playing strategy tips, consult Chapter 3 in my *Ultimate Blackjack Strategy Guide*.

Your 7 Upcard Playbook
When a dealer shows a 7 upcard, they have about a 26% chance of busting and about a 74% chance of getting to a final hand that totals 17 through 21 (rule dependent). Because of the latter, we have to be more aggressive when we are dealt a stiff hand (hit rather than stand) and less aggressive when we are dealt a two-card soft hand (hit rather than double down).
What follows is the accurate blackjack playing strategy for any hand in which the dealer shows a 7 upcard.
Fortunately for blackjack players, the playing strategy against a casino dealer's 7 up card is nearly the same for any number of decks of cards or mix of playing rules. There is one exception and you'll find it below.

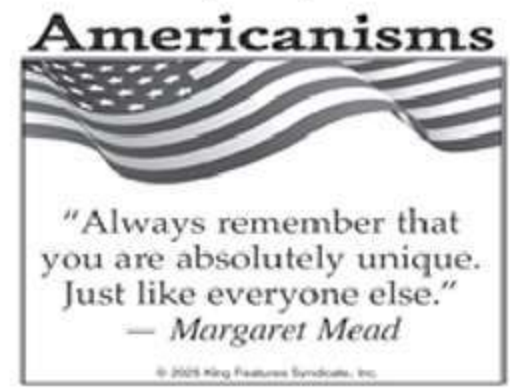

First-Time Lottery Player Wins Big

A North Carolina man has won the top prize in the state's lottery after playing for the first time. Jarett Allen from Burnsville won \$5,000,000 in the N.C. lottery after purchasing a \$30 200X The Cash ticket from his local Riverside General Store, according to an official news release. According to the release, the lucky winner decided to play the lottery alongside his dad at the time, who also enjoys playing. "It was the first lottery ticket I've ever bought," Allen said, further recalling that "My dad chose the ticket for me." Allen is the last winner of the state's six top lottery prizes and said he couldn't believe the outcome when the numbers were revealed. "I didn't think it was real," he noted. "I thought I wasn't looking at it right." Allen decided to collect the lump sum as his prize instead of receiving a yearly payment of \$250,000 over 20 years — bringing home \$2,152,508 after required state and federal tax withholdings, per the release. Allen now plans to invest his winnings after helping out his parents with their finances.

Two More Texas Millionaires

If you're a vigilant lottery player, every time a winner is announced, you probably can't help thinking, "when is it going to be my turn?" The Texas Lottery world has been buzzing with several wins reported across the state, one being in the Alamo City. Most recently, two Texans won millions off of winning lottery tickets, one becoming a multimillionaire. The big-prize winner is a resident of Euless, a suburb of Dallas and Fort Worth, who claimed a top prize-winning ticket worth \$3 million in the scratch game 30X Supreme, according to the Texas Lottery. The win was the first of four top prizes worth \$3 million to be claimed in this game. Supreme offers over \$162.3 million in total prizes, with the overall odds of winning any prize being one in 3.76, including break-even prizes. Texas Lottery's second lucky winner is a Houston resident, who purchased a Texas Two Step jackpot prize worth \$1.275 million. The Texan's winning Quick Pick ticket matched all four of the white ball

numbers drawn: 4-10-25-28 and the red bonus ball: 33. Texas Two Step jackpots start at \$200,000, and the prize amount increases each drawing until there is a winner, according to the Texas Lottery.

Lucky Win, Lost Ticket

A Kentucky couple ended up winning a \$50,000 lottery prize after finding a ticket that had been lost for months.

It all began when Mark Perdue purchased a Powerball ticket at an AM Express store in Bowling Green, where he is a regular customer, according to the Kentucky Lottery officials. When he returned about a week later to purchase a soda, he was congratulated by the store's owner. "I said, 'For what?'" Perdue recalled. "And she said, 'You won the lottery.' I said, 'I wish.' She said, 'You did, I have you on video.'" Then came the hard part: finding the ticket. Perdue and his wife spent over three months searching for it and eventually assumed it was gone for good. Fortunately, Perdue, who is the president of automotive supply company, had luck on his side. A manager from another plant was in town for a visit and needed a company car. And when Perdue inspected the vehicle, he saw the winning Powerball ticket in the front seat. He believes the ticket fell out of his pocket when he'd last used the car. Perdue took a snap of the ticket and texted it to his wife. The relieved couple then dropped by lottery headquarters and left with a check for \$36,000 after taxes. The Perdues said they would use their winnings to pay off their bills and maybe even go on a vacation.

Nevada Happenings

Lenny Kravitz Returns

Lenny Kravitz, who refuses to age (though he's turning 61 this year), did a five-show sold-out residency last fall at Dolby Live at Park MGM and will do five more this August. Kravitz's music is a fusion that ranges from hard rock to funk, reggae, soul, and R&B. He made history by winning the Grammy Award for Best Male Rock Vocal Performance four years in a row (1999-2002), setting the record for most consecutive wins in one category by a male performer; he's also won many other awards over the years and has sold more than 40 million albums in his 36-year career. The new dates are August 1, 2, 6, 8, and 9.

Marinelli's Serving Breakfast

Marinelli's, the red-tablecloth fine Italian restaurant with big picture windows at M Resort, has started serving breakfast. The prices are reasonable, with three eggs and bacon/sausage at \$14, French toast, pancakes, and waffles \$12, bagel and lox platter \$16, smoothies \$9, and seasonal berries \$8. Marinelli's also serves classic (\$15) and filet mignon (\$26) Benedicts, huevos (\$14) and breakfast burrito (\$12), and steak and eggs (\$26). Mimosas are \$9 and Bloody Marys \$14.

VooDoo Lounge Returns

VooDoo Steak, which occupies the 51st and 52nd floors of the Rio, has been open for some time, though VooDoo Lounge, the associated ultra lounge, "permanently" closed during the pandemic. Well, apparently, permanently meant five years or so, because VooDoo Lounge reopened in January. According to the Rio's website, "The wait is over—VooDoo Lounge has returned. Perched high above the city, this ultra lounge is your gateway to unforgettable evenings. From bold cocktails to panoramic views and a live DJ setting the vibe, every

moment invites you to play, explore, and savor the good life." There's no cover, but "upscale attire" is required and beers are \$9-\$10, cocktails \$17, bottle service \$200-\$850, and VIP seating packages \$250-\$1,500.

Country Comes to Sphere

Kenny Chesney has announced a 12-date residency at Sphere, the first country act to appear in the dome. The 56-year-old Chesney, who has a rabid following known as "No Shoes Nation," released his first album in 1994 and his 20th album, *Born*, came out last March. He's sold 30 million units over the course of his 30-year career, spawning 27 singles that have made it to the top 40 of the Billboard Hot 100, and headlined 18 arena tours. He's been awarded 12 Country Music Association awards, including Entertainer of the Year four times, 11 Academy of Country Music awards, including Entertainer of the Year (2005 to 2008), and has been nominated for six Grammy awards. The shows will be on: May 22, 24, 25, 28, 30, and 31 and June 4, 6, 7, 11, 13, and 14.

BLVD Construction Completed

BLVD, the massive 4-story 400,000-square-foot retail, dining, and entertainment project, has completed construction. Across from Aria (with a great view of it from the second-floor patio at Whataburger), BLVD opened to the public during F1, when the two-story Puma store unlocked its doors. The rest of the announced retailers were slated to open in early 2025. Initial retailers include Lululemon, Abercrombie & Fitch, British sportswear retailer JD Sports, Danish jeweler Pandora, mini department store H&M, and Adidas. In N Out has announced a major outlet, but that isn't opening for another year or so.
