



Historic Online Jackpot in U.S.

An online slot player in New Jersey won the largest jackpot in the history of this nation's legalized online-casino industry this summer. The player was making \$200 bets on a Fruit Blaster five-reel slot with The Big One progressive at the BetMGM online casino when the symbols lined up for the record \$6.4 million jackpot. BetMGM casino platforms awarded nearly \$140 million in progressive-jackpot payouts in 2023, a 32% increase over 2022's total.

#### Most Expensive Hotel Refresh Ever

The \$1.5 billion "refresh" of the Venetian/ Palazzo is Las Vegas is being touted as "the most extensive and expensive hotel renovation in history." All of the Venetian's original 4,000 suites are being redesigned, several new restaurants are replacing old ones, new high-limit and poker rooms and the sports book have been introduced, the 1,000-seat Voltaire Theater has opened, Shin Lim will debut his show at the Palazzo Theater in October, and the convention center is receiving \$200 million in upgrades. One change that had the attention of Vegas insiders is the importing of Gjelina, a southern California restaurant known for its farm-to-table cuisine; Gjelina's sustainabledriven menu and sourcing practices are eliciting support from local farmers.

Caesars is selling the intellectual-property rights to the World Series of Poker to NSUS Group for \$500 million. NSUS is an internet gaming investment group that started the online poker room, GGPoker. The transaction consists of \$250 million in cash and a \$250 million note due five years after the deal closes; if it's not paid, the rights revert to Caesars. Caesars will host the live tournaments at Paris and the Horseshoe for 20 years; Caesars' brick-and-mortar poker rooms will continue to feature WSOP branding and Caesars destinations will receive preferential rights to host live WSOP Circuit events. NSUS will also issue Caesars Digital a license to continue operating its recently upgraded WSOP Online poker business in Nevada, New Jersey, Michigan, and Pennsylvania for the foreseeable future, but will otherwise be restricted from operating online peer-to-peer real-money poker operations for a specified period of time and subject to certain exceptions. The deal is expected to close by the end of this

Caesars Sells WSOP Brand

An Indiana casino that currently has a home overlooking the Ohio River in southeast Indiana may be moving further north—more specifically, to New Haven. That's according to information issued by Hannah News Service, a provider of statehouse news for Indiana, Kentucky, Illinois, South Carolina, and Ohio. Full House Resorts, Inc. oversees Rising Star Casino Resort. Its Rising Sun hotel is in Ohio County, on Indiana's southeastern border near Cincinnati, and its revenue has been on the decline. Dan Lee, the resort company's president and CEO, named the Fort Wayne area as a potential spot for relocation as far back as 2017. Already in 3. Where was "Give Peace a Chance" New Haven is Winner's Circle, a satellite wagering and sportsbook pub off SR 930 and Minnich Road operated by Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. It would also be a change in landscape for the casino, which includes a static riverboat at its current home looking onto the Ohio River. More details are expected after the 2025 State Legislative Session, and there is not yet a timeline for making the casino a reality in New Haven.



I would guess that in theory any electronic device can be "rigged"—that is, it can be programmed to perform a task in a particular way. So of course, if one of those functions is the number and type of packs a player receives at Bingo, it is logical that a person could request and pay for six-packs and receive 10-packs if the programmer chooses to punch in that code.

However, a Bingo hall that allowed this to happen would not be around for long. As a state licensed wagering entity, Bingo halls match the number and types of packs being sold, an audit would quickly reveal this







Your expected return if you played perfectly (which they don't) is 97.87%. 



It isn't that charity Bingos don't want to increase the prize money; the fact is they can't. Charity Bingo is considered gambling and is therefore regulated by the states. Part of that regulation includes setting limits on how much money a charity Bingo can offer per session. And as you say, Les, it tends to be fairly low.

If you'd like to see a change, one thing you can do is to call and write to your state's gaming board and state assembly representatives and say that as a Bingo playing citizen you would like to see prize levels increased. You can encourage your fellow Bingo players to do the same.

1 cup carrots, julienned or grated

Cook the vernicelli noodles according to package instructions. Rinse under cold water, drain and set aside. Prepare the vegetables and herbs. Choose and prepare your protein and specialty ingredients.

To assemble: Fill a large shallow dish with warm water. divapatti@divasonadime.com Dip one rice paper wrapper into the water for about 10 seconds until it's soft but still slightly

firm (it will continue to soften while rolling). Lay the softened rice paper on a clean, flat surface. These are sticky; you may wish to use parchment paper as your preparation surface. Word of advice: Rolling these takes a little practice. Don't expect your first try to come out perfect. Remember, even the ugly ones are still delicious!

In the lower third of the wrapper, place a small handful of vermicelli noodles, followed by a few pieces of lettuce, carrots, cucumber and herbs. Add protein and other ingredients. Roll the salad roll:

Start by folding the bottom edge of the wrapper over the filling. Then fold in the sides tightly, followed by rolling it away from you to enclose the filling completely. The rolls should be snug but not too tight. Continue this process with the remaining wrappers and filling ingredients.

## Do Not Slowplay in Poker or Run the Risk of Ruin!

In a recent \$1,000 buy-in tournament at the World Series of Poker (WSOP), everyone folded to me in the hijack seat — the spot two right of the dealer button — and I raised to 500 out of my 12,000 effective stack holding the QsJs at 100/200 with a 200 big blind ante. So far, I have played a relatively tight. aggressive strategy. The player in the cutoff, who was unknown to me, called, as did the player on the button, and both blinds folded.

When you raise before the flop and do not get reraised, it is safe to assume that you are not against premium preflop hands, such as pocket aces and ace-king. Instead, you are usually against a range of reasonable hands

I have to put in 2,800 more to win the 10,000 pot plus the 2,800 more I would be putting in, meaning I needed to win at least 2,800/12,800 = 22% of the time. In the worstcase scenario, when my opponent has three of a kind, I will only win 18% of the time, making this call slightly unprofitable. Against three of a kind though, I will likely be able to get the rest of my stack in on the river when I make a flush. If my opponent has a worse including marginal pairs, big cards, and suited hand than three of a kind though, my call is immediately profitable.




