

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HOLLYWOOD — Fans of former Superman Henry Cavill are desperate for him to be the next James Bond, judging from their efforts to mislead people with a bogus trailer of him as 007 on social media! The trailer co-stars (thanks to AI technology) Barbie herself, Margot Robbie, in certain action scenes. It flooded social media, and many believed it was real.

Barbara Broccoli, who inherited the franchise from her father, Cubby Broccoli, in 1996, will probably go for a younger actor than the 41-year-old Cavill, who didn't fare well as a CIA agent in The Man From U.N.C.L.E (2015). The spy film only grossed \$110 million against its \$75 million cost. His exposure as a ruthless, burly CIA assassin who was bested by Tom Cruise in "Mission: Impossible — Fallout" (made \$791.7 million) may be hard for 007 fans to forget.

Aaron Taylor-Johnson, 34, is most often mentioned as the front runner to play Bond. Cavill's more preoccupied these days with the baby girl he and girlfriend, Natalie Viscuso (vice president of Vertigo Entertainment), welcomed in January. He began filming Voltron, a sci-fi action film based on the animated series of the same name. It began shooting in December in Queensland, Australia, with Sterling K. Brown and Rita Ora.

Meanwhile, Margot Robbie is in the United Kingdom shooting a reboot of the 1939 MGM classic Wuthering Heights. She stars as Catherine Earnshaw (who was originally played by Merle Oberon, opposite Laurence Olivier's Heathcliff). Robbie's version of Catherine will star opposite Jacob Elordi's Heathcliff for a February 2026 release.

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New VA Secretary Doug Collins

Changes are coming fast and furious at the Department of Veterans Affairs. Since these impact many of us, we need to pay attention to what's going on - and who's now in charge.


The VA has a new secretary, Douglas A. Collins, the 12th in the position since the VA was started in 1988. Collins is an Air Force veteran, served as chaplain, has been a Reserve colonel for 23 years and additionally served for two years in the Navy. He served in Iraq and at his confirmation hearing said that he slept next to burn pits for many months. He's an attorney and was a U.S. representative for a Georgia district from 2013 to 2021.

Quite the resume, and the Senate vote to confirm him was fairly strong: 77 to 23.

He's jumped right in, saying he wants to expand the VA's private sector care and figure out how to get rid of employees who aren't doing their job. He stopped the employee teleworking right away, insisting people come back to work, and put a hiring freeze in place until things shake out and they see if there are any vacancies once people decide if they're staying or going. Further, he vowed to fix the \$16 billion computer system that's been sitting unfinished for two years.

Sometimes you just want to see a man and hear his voice before you make up your mind about him. Go online to YouTube and look for "Doug Collins opening remarks in Veterans Affairs secretary confirmation hearing.'

Watching that video, I liked things about him that have nothing directly to do with the VA and the position he's been given, but instead tell what kind of a man he is. He's been married 36 years, he still has a bracelet a female Airman made for him when he was a flightline chaplain 15 years ago and he thanked his 88-year-old father. In the end, those things matter. I wish him well.






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



BINGO LAND NEWS FROM THE REAL WORLD & CYBERSPACE

Bingo Big in Brazil Bingo, which has had a turbulent legal history in Brazil, is on the verge of a legitimate comeback. While the game was banned in the early 2000s due to concerns over money laundering and illegal gambling, a legislative shift is currently on the table. Having passed the approval of the Senate in 2024, dedicated new bills are expected to reintroduce bingo halls under a more regulated framework. This would provide significant opportunities for both local and international investors. Brazilian Senate projections envision 1.5 million direct and indirect jobs and potential annual revenues of R\$22bn, benefitting states, municipalities and the central government. Indeed, recent legislative changes are reaching further. After finetuning the sports betting and online casino rules in 2024, industry stakeholders expect a comprehensive framework for lotteries, bingo and land-based casino facilities. This regulatory evolution is part of a broader effort to modernize Brazil's gambling sector, moving it away from state monopolies.


Furbaby Bingo a Hit

There are many reasons to attend the annual Furbaby Bingo event in Goldsboro, North Carolina—from the fun to the stellar prizes, but it is also an important fundraiser for the Animal Welfare League of Wayne County to help improve the lives of companion animals around Wayne County. The fundraiser was first held in 2024 and raised \$2,000, according to Donna Archer, board secretary. "It may not sound like a lot, but that money

is very important. We used the money to start a spay, neuter voucher program, and we had 44 spayed. We gave \$500 to the shelter for food around Christmas time," Donna says. When Hurricane Helene hit, they took a big hit in donations. But despite that they went to work gathering donations of pet food—a collection drive that turned so big that the YMCA partnered with them. They drove seven box trucks worth of supplies to western North Carolina with pet food in each one

Lower the Pressure

UK company Buzz Bingo recently collaborated with LoSalt and the Stroke Association to reduce stroke risk and promote heart health, launching a new initiative to help reduce high blood pressure and stroke risk throughout the UK. Working with LoSalt and the Stroke Association, Buzz Bingo introduced LoSalt at its venues in Gateshead and Stockport, areas which have been identified as stroke hotspots. This came ahead of Stroke Prevention Day on January 30th, where Buzz Bingo hosted a live-streamed charity bingo game in all of its clubs, to raise money for the Stroke Association. On top of this, there are other fundraising activities with the aim of raising £200,000 (\$248,296.07) by the end of this year. Buzz Bingo Head of Brand Communications Mark Fletcher said: "We're empowering our customers to make informed decisions about their health while supporting the Stroke Association's vital work."

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Arizona Charlie's Decatur and Boulder Awarded More Than \$2.7 Million in Jackpot Winnings in February

LAS VEGAS - March 11, 2025 - Golden Entertainment's Arizona Charlie's Boulder. located at 4575 Boulder Hwy and Arizona Charlie's Decatur, located at 740 S. Decatur Blvd, awarded a combined total of \$2,796,227 in jackpot winnings in February. The majority of the winnings came from slot jackpots, which totaled \$2,393,942, while an impressive \$402,285 was awarded through the casinos' award-winning bingo games.

A lucky local kicked off the month at Arizona Charlie's Decatur, winning \$12,453 on a Dragon Link slot machine after betting just \$0.10 on Tuesday, Feb. 4. Another big jackpot win came at the end of the month, on Monday, Feb. 24, when a guest won \$18,722 on an 88 Fortunes slot machine. The winning continued at Arizona Charlie's Boulder, where a player hit a \$19,164 jackpot while playing a Lock It Link slot machine on Thursday, Feb. 6.

Both locations also paid out large bingo jackpots in February, with a Charlie's Double Progressive awarded at each casino. On Friday, Feb. 14, lucky bingo player Robert W. at Boulder won \$58,528 and just two days later, on Sunday, Feb. 16 a bingo player at Decatur took home \$67,552.

— 3 cups lukewarm water

-1 1/2 tablespoons granulated yeast

-1 1/2 tablespoons kosher salt - 6 1/2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour

Mix together ingredients in a 5-quart foodgrade lidded bucket or container. Cover loosely, let rise at room temperature for about 2 hours, then refrigerate for up to two weeks.

Bake some of the dough now, if you wish. To prepare a loaf, cut off a grapefruit-sized piece of dough, sprinkle flour on it, and briefly shape it into a ball with flour-covered hands. Allow it to rest for 40 minutes on a pizza peel or a wooden board covered with parchment paper (or sprinkled with cornmeal).

Twenty minutes before baking, preheat oven to 450 F. Then set a baking stone on a rack in the center of the oven and an empty broiler tray on the lower rack. When ready to bake, dust the top of the loaf with flour. An adult should make a 1/4-inch-deep crisscross slash on top with a sharp knife and slide the dough onto the baking stone. Pour a cup of hot water into the broiler pan before closing the oven door.

Bake for 30 minutes, or until crust is browned. Let cool. Slice and serve.







16 ounces uncooked shrimp (41-60 size). thawed and peeled

- 1 fresh lemon, see note below*
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/2 cup red bell pepper, diced
- 2 cups long-grain white rice 2 cups chicken broth
- 1 teaspoon Old Bay Seasoning

2 tablespoons chopped parsley (optional)

Prep the Ingredients: If using frozen shrimp, thaw and peel before starting.

*Zest the lemon, reserving the zest. Slice lemon in half, juice half the lemon (about 2 tablespoons juice) and slice the other half

Saute the Garlic and Rice: Heat a deep skillet over medium heat. Add butter and garlic, and red pepper, sauteing until fragrant (1-2 minutes). Stir in the rice and continue



sauteing for another 1-2 minutes until the rice begins to toast lightly. You might hear a faint crackling sound.

Add Liquid and Seasoning: Carefully pour in the chicken broth, water, lemon juice and half the lemon zest. Stir in the Old Bay and parsley. Give everything a good stir to combine.

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SENIOR NEWS LINE by Matilda Charles Don't Fall for **Medicare Scams**

Medicare card scams are on the rise. During one calendar year, Medicare had over \$100 billion in fraudulent claims, and the damage cost goes up when identity theft and stolen financial information are added in.

What the Medicare thieves want is your card number, and they'll try any number of tricks to get you to reveal it.

Scammers might contact you to offer you a "cheaper" Medicare but will need your personal information to sign you up.

They might impersonate a Medicare employee and say that your card is about to expire and you need a new one. They'll ask for your current card number and your personal information to verify it's really vou. (Wrong: Medicare cards don't expire.)

Scammers might call and say that your Medicare benefits have been canceled, but claim they can help you get the benefits reinstated if you give them your personal information or even a fee. (Wrong: Medicare won't communicate with you that way, and if they need to contact you, it will be by mail.)

Thieves might try to claim that your old paper card isn't good now and that you need a new one with a chip in it, like a credit card. (Wrong: Medicare cards are only made of paper.)

They might offer you a refund of some type or something free, or you might be offered genetic testing. All you need to do, they'll say, is give them your Medicare card number ... and your bank information for the refund.

Whether vou're contacted by phone. email or text message, don't give out your Medicare card number or any of your personal or financial information.

As usual, if you suspect you have a scammer on the phone, hang up immediately. If you believe it was an attempt at a Medicare scam, call 800-MEDICARE (800-633-4227) to report it.



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


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Know the Implied Odds By Jonathan Little

Whenever you face a bet at the poker table, it is important to consider your immediate risk, your future potential risk, and also the amount you can potentially profit. Sometimes you should play speculative hands — like small pairs and suited connectors - and other times they should be folded.

Suppose someone raises to two big blinds (bbs) and you have a solid speculative hand like the 8c6c on the button, which is likely the worst hand at the moment but can improve to a premium hand like a flush or a straight.

The amount you can potentially win from your opponent should be one of your main concerns. If you can only win a little bit from your opponent because they have a short stack of perhaps 26bbs or fewer, you should fold because the potential reward (26bbs) is not worth the risk (2bbs). This is expressed as 13:1 implied odds. You have to invest 1 unit to potentially win 13. If you are both deep stacked with 100bbs though, you should play because you will then be getting 50:1 implied odds.

As a generalization, in order to profitably play a suited connected hand like 7c7s or a marginal suited Ace like the Ah7h, you need to be getting 20:1 implied odds or more, assuming you do not expect to be able to win the pot by bluffing too often. With small pairs, you need about 10:1 implied odds. If you are not getting the correct implied odds either because the stacks are shallow or the initial

We are having a big party and I want to serve chicken wings. Can you make some suggestions for recipes? Thank you. Marilyn D from The Villages, Florida

Dear Marilyn,

I love chicken wings. Here are three of my favorite recipes. If you are serving a big crowd, prepare all three recipes. —Annie

SWEET AS CAN BE WINGS

- 3 lbs. chicken wings $\frac{1}{2}$ c. honey $\frac{1}{4}$ c. soy sauce 4 T. brown sugar 1 clove garlic, crushed ¹/₄ cup catsup Salt, to taste
- Pepper, to taste Paprika

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a shallow baking pan with aluminum foil. Place the chicken in the pan. Sprinkle with

raise is too large, you either have to fold or use your hand as a reraise bluff.

While small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors have implied odds, some hands have reverse implied odds, meaning they will usually either win a small pot or lose a large pot. The hands that have the worst reverse implied odds are a big card with a small card that are not suited, such as Ks6c or Qd7d. Imagine you see the flop and make top pair, which is normally a strong hand. If you

bet and all your opponents fold, you can be confident you had the best hand, but you are rewarded with only a small pot. If instead you bet and someone calls or raises, they could have a better top pair than yours or a worse hand, but you have no way of knowing which.

If you bet the flop and they call, if you continue betting on the turn and river, you will find that when you get called, it will usually be by a better hand, resulting in you losing a large pot.

Because of this, hands with large reverse implied odds should not be played in most situations, especially in multi-way pots or when the stacks are deep.

As stacks get deeper and the pots are played multi-way, you are more incentivized to speculate with hands that will either lose a little or win a lot, which are primarily the small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors. Folding the non-premium offsuit hands will keep you out of trouble and save you a lot of monev

Add margarine mixture to pan and gently toss chicken until well coated, 1 to 2 minutes. Serve with celery pieces and blue cheese dressing. Serves 18.

FIVE SPICE CHICKEN WINGS

2 scallions, chopped $\frac{1}{2}$ cup soy sauce $\frac{1}{2}$ cup drv sherry ¹/₄ cup brown sugar 2 tsp. Chinese 5-spice seasoning 1 tsp. sesame oil 4 lbs. chicken wings

Using a large heavy saucepan, combine all of the above ingredients except the chicken. Bring to a boil for a medium heat. Add the chicken and simmer. Stir constantly. Cook for 30 minutes with a lid on the saucepan. You can find the seasoning in an Oriental grocery, if not available in your regular grocery store. Serves 12.




